

2nd District Committee Meeting June 4, 2006

Temporary chair Norman Sterzenbach called meeting to order at 2:00 pm at the Trinity Methodist Church, Riverside. Christy was introduced as the new finance person for the Loeb sack Campaign Jeanette Kline requested that updates on the persons elected to the 2nd district committee be sent to her including all contact information.

Our website organization was discussed. Harvey Ross announced recent difficulties and urged people to send updates of county events, as we need to share this information.

DJ Arnold gave the treasurers report. We have a balance of \$6,202.69. The treasurer's report was approved, then it was moved and approved to donate \$1,000 to the Loeb sack campaign to max the primary contributions allowed and then another donation of \$4,000 for after the primary.

Angel Gonzales spoke on working with the state staffer(s) and the need for additional affirmative action chairs to be elected in all counties.

The state central committee members reported on the new rural outreach program, state training sessions, and fundraising.

A discussion of the district convention was held. Comments included the huge amount of goodwill and positive feelings that were achieved. The accommodations for the disabled persons was handled very well, in part due to the list provided through that caucus.

Arrangements had some difficulty learning names for the committees from counties.

There were some complaints about the sound problems and a person felt that Internet access should be provided. Also, future elections of committee members to representation at the state convention should be changed so that there is not a conflict with committee meetings or lunch.

James Moody nominated Norman Sterzenbach as chair and he was elected. After some discussion it was suggested to delay other elections until others could be notified of all the openings: vice chair, secretary and treasurer. Joe Michalec was appointed temporary secretary.

Fundraising was next discussed. The need for a successful fundraiser over the next 50 days was pointed out. Suggestions were made that we have a com boil, with the items donated so there would be a 100% profit or a Un party. It was unanimous that we have the UN party. Our homework for the next meeting is to decide on which committee to serve.

A constitution committee was formed to review our current constitution. Linda Chavez, Harvey Ross, Michelle Michalec and Sandy Dockendorf volunteered.

It was moved that the date of the next meeting be at the discretion of the chair.
